



# I-10 Bridges over the Gila River

**Project Overview:** The I-10 bridges over the Gila River are at the end of their service life and require frequent and expensive deck and foundation repairs. The existing river crossing includes two quarter-mile-long bridges, one for east- and one for westbound I-10, each carrying two lanes of traffic over the Gila River. These bridges will be replaced with modern, wider bridges to carry three lanes of traffic in each direction with 12-foot wide shoulders.
